e. Approval of Michael Wahlert's appointment to the Planning and Zoning Commission.

Sacker moved supported by Tweed to adopt and approve Resolution #2016-14, "A Resolution Adopting the Revised Consent Agenda." Passed unanimously.

- 8) Mayor Adams asked Parks and Rec Coordinator Brayton to present the proposed memorandum of understanding with the Van Meter Youth Soccer Club. Brayton explained that the MOU provided for the soccer board to turn over all physical and liquid assets to the City of Van Meter in order for the City to provide youth soccer programming and also to make certain capital improvements at the rec complex. Brayton noted that the Soccer Board would remain in place as an organization in order to provide structure and advice to the Parks and Rec Department concerning youth soccer opportunities in Van Meter. The cash would be used to reconfigure the soccer fields to better utilize the space at the complex. Moved by Peterson supported by Tweed to approve the MOU as presented. Passed unanimously.
- 9) Mayor Adams asked Administrator Anderson to present the proposed ordinance amending the Code of Ordinances to establish per gallon water and sewer capital improvement fees. Anderson explained that consistent with the City Council's conversation with Bond Counsel and Financial Advisors an ordinance is being recommended to provide the water and sewer revenue necessary to support capital improvements more broadly but specifically the current proposal is aimed at paying for a drinking water treatment plant. The ordinance would enact a capital improvement fee for water that would increase two tenths of one cent every six months until a gallon of water generates one cent for capital improvements. The ordinance would also establish a new sewer fee at five hundredths of a cent per gallon for capital improvements. The sewer fee does not escalate until the ordinance is amended in the future. Anderson noted that no public comment had been received in writing. Mayor Adams opened the public hearing. Hearing none, Mayor Adams closed the public hearing and asked the Council for discussion. Hearing none, Mayor Adams asked for a motion to approve the second reading of the proposed ordinance. Peterson moved supported by Tweed. Passed unanimously. Sacker moved supported by Peterson to waive the third reading of the proposed ordinance. On roll call the votes were as follows: Stump - No; Peterson - Yes; Tweed - Yes; Sacker - Yes; Lyon - Yes. Motion passed. Sacker moved supported by Peterson to approve and adopt Ordinance 253, "Ordinance amending the Code of Ordinances of the City of Van Meter, Iowa, amending chapters concerning 'Water Rates' And 'Sewer Rates' to add Water and Sewer Capital Improvement Fees." On roll call the votes were as follows: Stump - No; Peterson - Yes; Tweed - Yes; Sacker - Yes; Lyon - Yes. Motion passed.

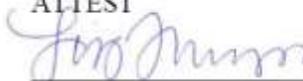

Staff present: City Administrator Jake Anderson, City Attorney/Parliamentarian John Fatino, Public Safety Director/Sergeant at Arms William Daggett, City Clerk Liz Thompson, Parks and Rec Director Alex Brayton, Public Works Director Dave Herman, and Police Officer Erik Faust.

- 2) Mayor Adams asked for a motion to approve the agenda. Moved by Peterson supported by Tweed. Passed unanimously.
- 3) Mayor Adams noted the Administrator's recommendation and his own recommendation for employee wage adjustments and asked the Council for discussion and action. Lyon moved supported by Stump to approve the Administrator's recommendations with the following amendments: City Clerk Thompson - \$47,630/year, Parks and Recreation Brayton - \$17.70/hour. On roll call the votes were as follows: Stump - Yes; Peterson – No; Tweed – No; Sacker – No; Lyon – Yes. Motion Failed. Tweed moved supported by Lyon to approve the Administrator's recommendations with the following amendments: City Clerk - \$47,630/year, Parks and Recreation - \$41,250/year, effective November 1, 2016 with the completion of the Police Academy Police Officer Faust - \$19.18/hour, effective December 1, 2016 Parks and Recreation Brayton - \$19.84/hour. On roll call the votes were as follows: Stump - Yes; Peterson – No; Tweed – Yes; Sacker – No; Lyon – Yes. Resolution #2016-15, "A Resolution Approving Wage Adjustments" passed.

Enclosed is a copy of the preliminary plat of survey and the plat of survey submitted by Jim Roberts for a portion of Lot 3 of Roberts Estates. Jim Roberts is planning to create one additional single family residential lot. The single family residential lot is located directly west of the two lots created in Roberts Acres.

The street frontage for Roberts Acres is Richard Circle located along the north side of Lot 3. Water service is available on the north side of Richard Circle. Sanitary sewer constructed by Jim Roberts to serve the two lots in Roberts Acres will serve the new lot.

The creation of Lot 3 does not require Jim Roberts to install any additional public utilities. Under the City of Van Meter's subdivision ordinance both a preliminary plat and a final plat are required. Because there are no public improvements, the City of Van Meter can approve the preliminary plat and the final plat simultaneously.

The surveyor for Jim Roberts, Ty Enderson, consulted with Dallas County and determined a plat of survey would be acceptable. The plat of survey serves the same purpose as the final plat required under the City of Van Meter's subdivision ordinance.

The difference between the final plat and a plat of survey deals with the designation of the parcels. With a final plat both the newly created lot and the residual portion of Lot 3 of Roberts Acres would be designated as lots in the new subdivision created by the final plat. With a plat of survey there is no complete replatting of Lot 3 of Roberts Acres. The plat of survey creates a separate parcel designation for the new lot. The parcel designation is assigned by Dallas County based on the location and number of property splits within the section. With the plat of survey the designation of Lot 3 of the original Roberts Acres remains unchanged except the designation will be Lot 3 of Roberts Acres less the newly created Parcel 17-104.

The writer believes there is a slight preference for the platting process as it creates more easily identifiable lot numbers. However, for the creation of a single parcel the plat of survey procedure is acceptable.

The newly created lot appears to meet the requirements of the City with respect to its zoning ordinance. The lot has adequate size and the setbacks for a buildable area. The writer would note the distance from the southerly line of the new lot to the building on the existing Lot 3 is just greater than the side yard setback required under the City's subdivision ordinance. Because the existing Lot 3 fronts against Richland Road, the north line of the residual Lot 3 would be considered a side yard against the new lot and the side yard setback would be acceptable.

The writer did not require the plat of survey to meet all of the requirements of the ordinance. The writer only required the preliminary plat to meet the basic requirements to illustrate what was intended with respect to the new lot. From an engineering and zoning perspective the preliminary plat of survey and plat of survey are satisfactory.

The preliminary plat of survey and plat of survey are being transmitted to the City of Van Meter for review and consideration by the Plan & Zoning Commission and the City Council. As indicated earlier the City can consider the approval of the preliminary plat and the plat of survey simultaneously.

The City will need to consult with City Attorney Eric Fisk to determine what documents he will require with respect to the plat of survey. Although the plat of survey creates the same division of property contemplated by a final plat under the City's subdivision ordinance, the creation of the single lot does not automatically trigger the subdivision ordinance. It would appear the requirements of the ordinance relative to the submittal of documentation may not be required for the plat of survey.
